CDOT is looking to evaluate more long-term, sustainable transportation-funding alternatives—one being the use of a road usage charge (RUC) for Colorado. In an RUC funding model, drivers pay for how many miles are traveled instead of the amount of fuel consumed.

Denver Transit Partners (DTP) was awarded the project on July 9, 2010. The project scopes include the design, build, finance, operation and maintenance of the East Rail Line between Denver Union Station (DUS) and Denver International Airport, the Gold Line between DUS and Arvada/Wheat Ridge, an initial segment of the Northwest Rail Line to South Westminster and the Commuter Rail Maintain Facility (CRMF).
