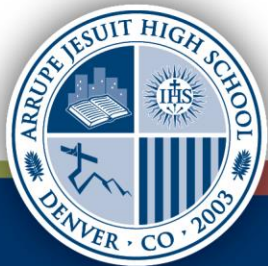
- Mission to break the cycle of poverty

- Average income family of 4 - \$40,000
- 80% qualify for Free & Reduced Lunch



Successes

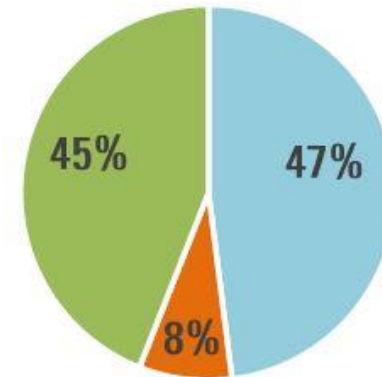


- 783 graduates since 2007

COST TO EDUCATE AN ARRUPE JESUIT STUDENT



- Student CWSP Earnings
- Average Family Tuition Contribution
- Philanthropic Support

Amount Earned through CWSP: **\$7,000**

Average Family Tuition Contribution: **\$1,300**

Average Gap Closed by Philanthropy: **\$6,500**

Total Cost to Educate a Student: **\$14,800**



Corporate Work Study Program



- In 2018-19, AJHS students will earn \$2.6 million
- Every student a CWSP employee
- 142 Partner Organizations
- Fee for service contract of \$28,000
- Team of four students = 1.0 FTE
- Invaluable professional experience
