Student Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a Displaced Worker. Displaced worker can include: laid off, furloughed, decreased wages and earnings, contract employees, and self-employed. **If you are not sure give us a call. We can help determine your eligibility.**
- New Student to MSU Denver, Transfer Student or a Re-Admit Student (Students who completely withdrew from Spring 2020 courses at MSU Denver or were enrolled at MSU Denver in Fall 2019 or previous semesters)
- Enrollees must be able to complete a certificate or a degree program at MSU Denver within 2 years of beginning the program

Students will receive:

- Tuition Assistance
- Academic Advising and success coaching
- Access to career readiness resources
