

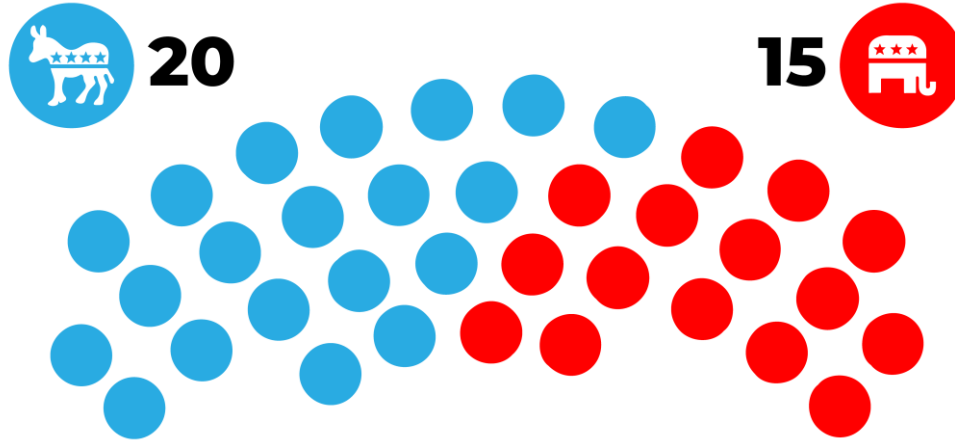
# BALLOT MEASURES

Approved 57.4%/42.6%
- **Proposition EE: Increase Taxes on Nicotine Products**  
Approved 68.1%/31.9%
- **Proposition 113: National Popular Vote**  
Approved 52.1%/47.9%
- **Proposition 114: Restoration of Gray Wolves**  
Approved 50.4%/49.6%
- **Proposition 116: State Income Tax Rate Reduction**  
Approved 57.7%/42.3%
- **Proposition 117: Voter Approval Fee-Based Enterprises**  
Approved 52.6%/47.4%
- **Proposition 118: Paid Family and Medical Leave**  
Approved 57.3%/42.7%

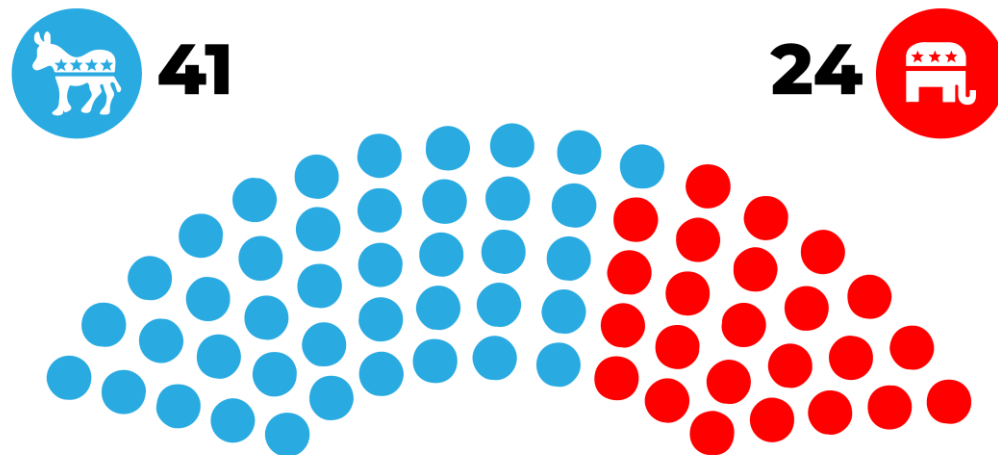


# LEGISLATIVE COMPOSITION
